Dr Rajagopala Chidambaram became the Director of the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC) in 1990. He was Chairman, Atomic Energy Commission, from 1993 to 2000. Since 2001, he is the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India. He was Chairman of the Board of Governors of the IAEA during 1994–95. He is Member of the Prime Minister’s Council on Climate Change and Chairman of the High-Level Committee for the National Knowledge Network. Dr Chidambaram was awarded the Padma Vibhushan, the second highest civilian award in India, in 1999.
