Deputy Secretary Hayes is the second highest ranking official at the U.S. Department of the Interior and serves as Chair of the President's Interagency Working Group on Coordination of Domestic Energy Development and Permitting in Alaska. As Chair, Hayes heads the U.S. effort to organize federal agencies that oversee energy development in Alaska and is a leader in promoting science-based decision-making for America's Arctic. Hayes is formerly the Global Chair of the Environment, Land and Resources Department at the international law firm Latham & Watkins and has served as Chairman of the Board of the non-profit Environmental Law Institute.
