Ms Kathleen Rogers, President of Earth Day Network, has worked for more than 20 years as an environmental attorney and advocate, focusing on international and domestic environmental public policy and law. Ms Rogers is the founder and thought leader behind the Women and Green Economy® (WAGE®) campaign. The WAGE® Campaign is actively creating a road map for women to aggregate their power and promote their leadership in creating a sustainable green economy and mitigating climate change. As a leader in the Women's and Girls track for the Clinton Global Initiative, Ms Rogers has had a strong influence on bringing attention to the affect that climate change will have on women and girls, as well as promoting female leadership in the emerging green economy. Ms Rogers was a leader on the panel on women's issues at the AREDAY conference in Aspen, CO and was the lead organizer of the WAGE® consultation in Delhi, in partnership with TERI. She was named one of 2010's top working mothers by Working Mother magazine. She has also been featured as Power Player of the Week on Fox News Sunday with Chris Wallace. Ms Rogers was awarded the Luminary award by Womensphere and the Urban Zen Foundation, given to women who are inspirations in their fields.

Under Ms Kathleen Roger's leadership, Earth Day Network has developed a significant role in advancing the new green economy and has emerged as a dynamic year-round policy and activist organization. Earth Day Network now reaches into 192 countries, embraces new constituencies—including youth and people of colour—and integrates civic participation into each of Earth Day Network's programmes and activities.
